Have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Is God's favor to us.

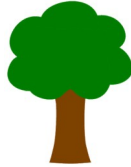
God has given us the wisdom

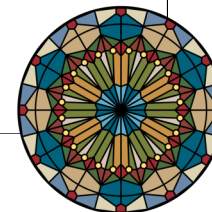

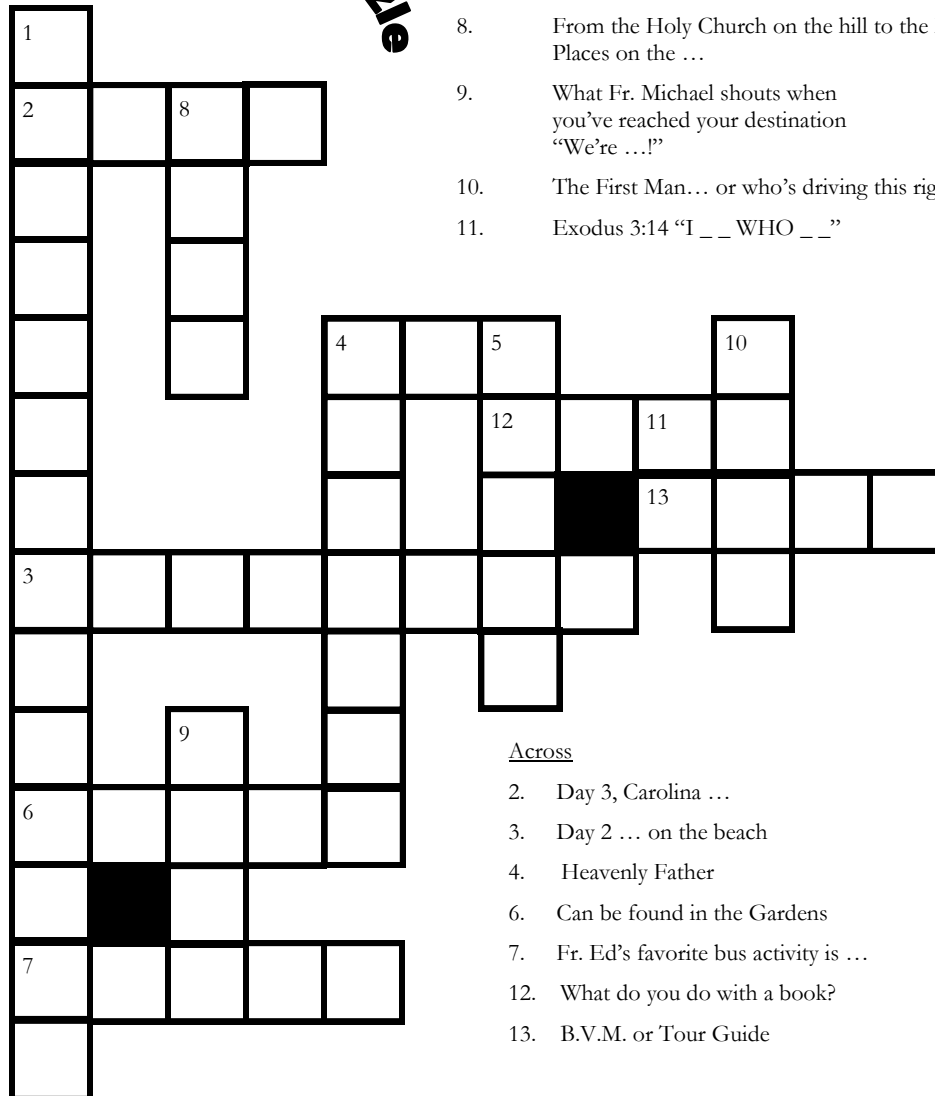
